PALM and BACKHAND

- Made of amara leather (no potential pollutants and allergens, hand washable up to 30 degrees)
- Padding in the thumb and palm area
- Finger joint and ankle protection with gathered padding
- Ca. 8 cm long cuff with reflective stripes
- Total length of the glove approx. 28 cm (size 10)
- Snap hook for attachment to the belt
- Circumferential elastic band in the palm and on the Back
- Reversible velcro fastener for better fit
- Available in size 4 to 12
